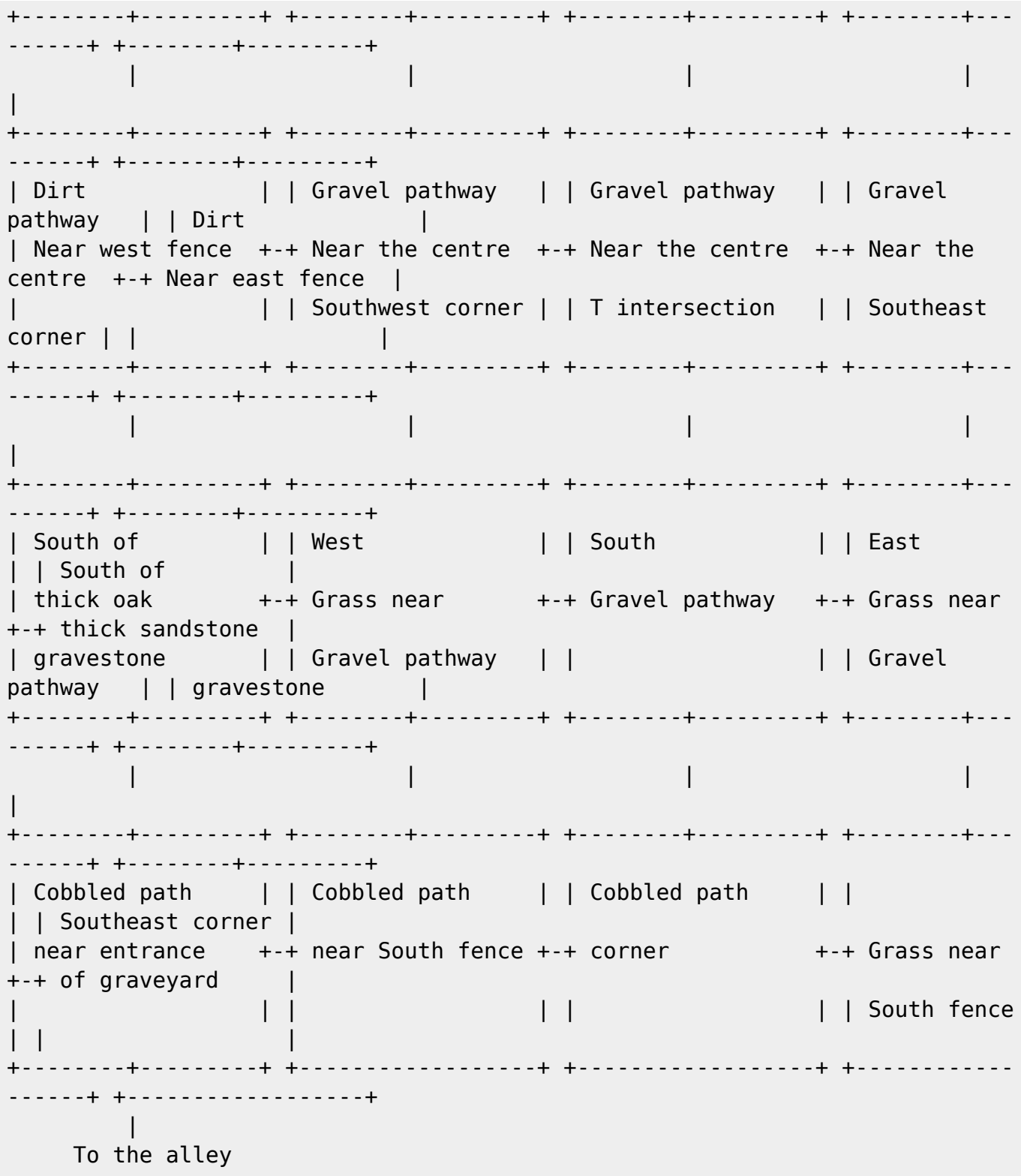

## Northwest corner of graveyard

A patchy grass area near the corner of the graveyard's north and west fences. Over the other side of the yard about halfway down, rising above the gravestones, you can see a large marble plinth. South of you is a grey marble gravestone. Further south you can make out the entrance to the graveyard.

## Gravel pathway near North fence Northwest corner

The corner of gravel pathway amongst the patchy grass near the northern fence of the graveyard. To the southeast and southwest are a few gravestones as well as the entrance to the graveyard to the south. To the southeast, rising above the gravestones, you can see a large marble plinth.

## Gravel pathway near North fence

A gravel pathway amongst the patchy grass near the northern fence of the graveyard. To the south of you is a white marble gravestone. To the southwest you can make out the entrance to the graveyard. To the southeast, rising above the gravestones, you can see a large marble plinth.

## Gravel pathway near North fence Northeast corner

The corner of gravel pathway amongst the patchy grass near the northern fence of the graveyard. To the southeast and southwest are a few gravestones as well as the entrance to the graveyard. To the southeast, rising above the gravestones, you can see a large marble plinth.

## Northeast corner of graveyard

A patchy grass area near the corner of the graveyard's north and east fences. Over the other side of the yard you can make out the entrance to the graveyard. South of you is a broken granite gravestone. Further south you, rising above the gravestones, you can see a large marble plinth.

**Southeast Gravel pathway****South of inscribed marble plinth**

Standing on a grave marked with an inscribed marble plinth. The statue that would have adorned the plinth has been broken off at the ankles. The plinth is about shoulder height. The graveyard fence is to the east and beyond it, rise trees.
